#### Week One

Tuesday morning, I had a radio interview with ABC Murray Goulburn Radio on the return to Remote Learning and provided a few reflections on the journey our College community has been through. Our staff have been working at express pace this week to prepare for the return to remote learning. The conversations considered the Term Two program as the benchmark for discussion on the strengths and difficulties that students, parents and staff had to deal with during Term Two. We explored many questions to ensure the Term Three program continues providing purposeful learning tasks within a remote learning environment.

The medical experts warned of a second wave unless there is complete eradication and true to their word it is happening. Victoria has a smaller geographical area; denser population per square kilometre and winter (does not help), all adding to the mix of the Covid -19 resurgence. Dr Stephen Barnett Head of Royal Melbourne Hospital Emergency Department said this morning, "I am not interested in finger pointing. A few months ago it was Tasmania, now its Victoria's turn and in a few months' time it will be somewhere else in Australia. This is an opportunity to learn." Stage Three Restrictions will calm the storm.

### What does it mean for St Mary's College?

We have been down this road before; the difficulties and inconveniences to daily life and now the College community focuses on what is required for the time in Stage Three Restrictions: *There are four reasons that we can leave home:* 

- 1. Shopping for food or other essential items.
- 2. To provide care giving, for compassionate reasons or to seek medical treatment.
- 3. For exercise (outdoor exercise only, with only one other person or members of your household).
- 4. Work or study, if we cannot work or study from home.

Otherwise, we stay home.

As was done in Term Two, College staff will do our best to support families both in learning and pastoral care. It is important that **students are not onsite unless it is essential.**
